

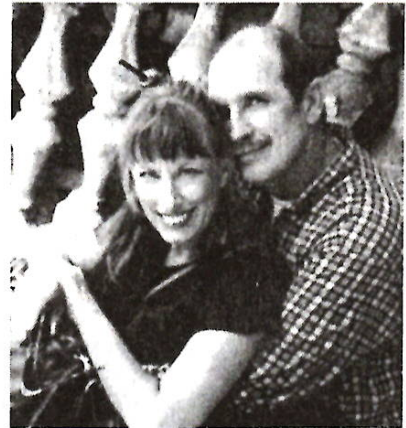

Albania

"Does it really work? Does this training have an effect? How do you know you are making a difference? How do you know lives are changed?" These are questions we are sometimes asked. God continues to show the answers and to affirm our call to this evangelism ministry.

July 2001-during a Youth EE Clinic, Suzy and a team shared the Gospel to three young sisters in their home carved from an abandoned factory. Their father had been electrocuted the previous Christmas putting up lights on Christmas Eve for the local missionary in a small, rural village in Albania. The sisters, their mother and brother then came to Tirana, the capital city to live in the abandoned factory. Bestkida, the oldest sister was very angry at God for "killing my father on *His son's* Birthday". After listening and sharing for sometime that day, the Holy Spirit touched Bestkida and her sister's hearts with His love and healing as they all accepted the Good News of the Gospel.

May 2002- on the day we were departing from Albania, we attended the Sunday worship service at the church where we had previously held two EE Clinics. With great delight we saw Bestkida, her sisters, brother, and mother at the church where they had been attending regularly since the previous year.

September 2002-Bestkida graduated from the first KIDS EE Clinic held in Tirana, taught by Don. She was excited to begin training other children's workers to share the Gospel with the hundreds of children who also live in the abandoned factories they call "home".

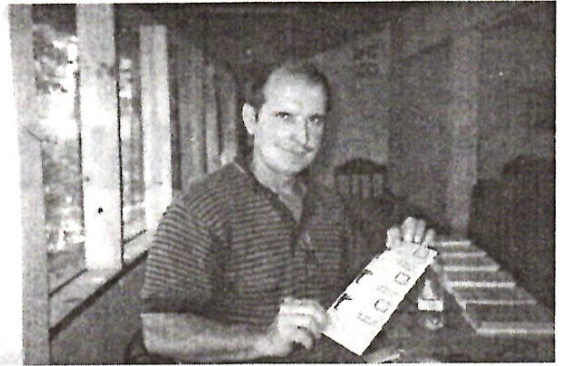

HAITI

EE training in Haiti continues to accelerate with more Clinics this year than in any of the past years. The Regional Leaders from both the North and South of Haiti were conducting simultaneous clinics as Don returned from Haiti in November. One clinic was held in a city where over 85% of the men were voodoo priests. In spite of this, the clinicians led many people out of spiritual darkness, *including* several voodoo priests. They publically burned their fetishes after their professions of faith.

Many of the Evangelism Explosion leaders are beginning to be self sufficient through the tent-making enterprises your gifts have provided. Businesses like printing materials and making books. Now with two additional Risographs they can print even more. Several of the leaders are making reading glasses through the "Glasses For Missions" project. This project provides an income and opportunity to share the Gospel as they help provide people with reading glasses.

At one Adult Clinic, children as young as 4 years old, who had been trained in KIDS EE, shared the Gospel. The adult Clinicians were amazed at the understanding and joy the children showed as they presented the Gospel.

Jay and Janet came from the US to participate in the KIDS EE Clinic in Belize with Don, Suzy, and Braman. While sharing the Gospel as part of their homework assignment, they led their taxi driver to the Lord one evening. Then they found out that his three children had attended a birthday party at his neighbor's and had accepted the Lord earlier the same day. His neighbor was a participant in the KIDS EE Clinic and had used this birthday party to do her homework assignment. She shared the Gospel with all the children at the party. After her presentation thirteen children prayed to receive Christ, including the taxi driver's three children! After the taxi driver prayed, the couple brought him to the home of the local pastor where the two of them made plans to meet the following Tuesday for discipleship training. The taxi driver's wife had become a Christian only weeks before. Now the family was united in their Christian faith. Jay and Janet were amazed at how God had used them to accomplish His purposes for this Belizian family.

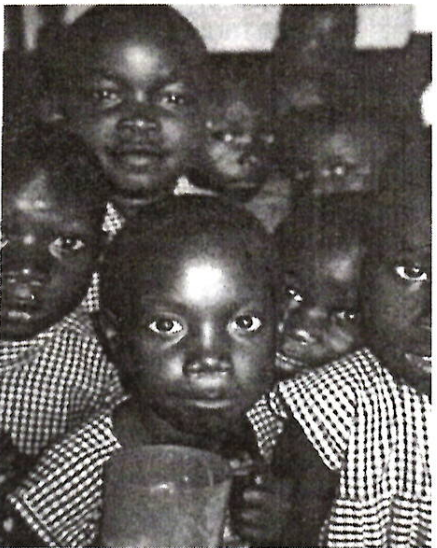
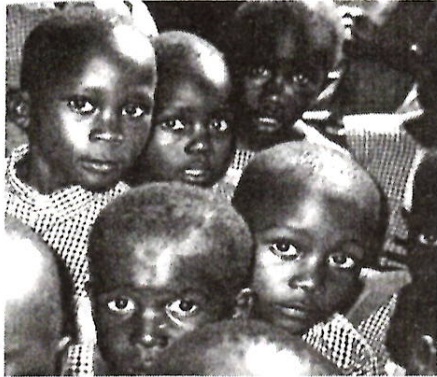
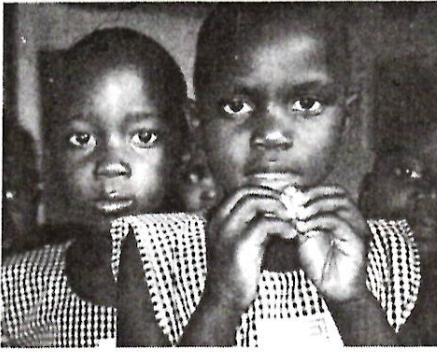
UNITED STATES

The clinicians were about to begin their On-The-Job Training for the KIDS EE Clinic at Moody Church. They entered the inner city housing project of Cabrini-Green in Chicago with fear and trepidation. The highrise building had wire mesh on the outside of the open walkways. Drugdealers and gang members cast menacing looks at the group as they entered this "no-man's-land".

Several of the clinicians who were Chicago residents had never before ventured near this rat infested, high density highrise. They weren't too sure about what they might encounter. A friend of one clinician couldn't believe that she was actually being asked to do this. But armed with the Gospel and shielded in prayer, they all went to visit children and families. Praise God, many children and their families prayed to receive Christ. The clinicians' faith was strengthened to see how God had gone before them, prepared hearts, and protected them. This experience led some of the clinicians who lived in Chicago to commit to return to Cabrini-Green and continue working with the kids through Moody Church.

Don became an honorary member of the Moru Tribe in Southern Sudan. They said only a few come to share with them, but even fewer return! They say he is truly their brother.

God graciously protected Don, Rev. Paul Hurst, Elise Glading, and the team of Nationals as they traveled and ministered in July in these difficult places. It isn't always this way. After Don returned, the EE leaders have continued to conduct evangelism training. Tragically, Rev. Godfrey Mogombo's brother was brutally attacked and murdered when traveling home on the same road that Don and Paul Hurst traveled. He was martyred because of his Christian faith. This road is now closed to travel. The overland trip that God allowed in July would not have been possible only weeks later.

We ask that you pray for the believers in these countries as they continue to share the message of salvation under these very dangerous conditions. The church leaders are asking for Don to return. Pray that God will provide for this trip.
