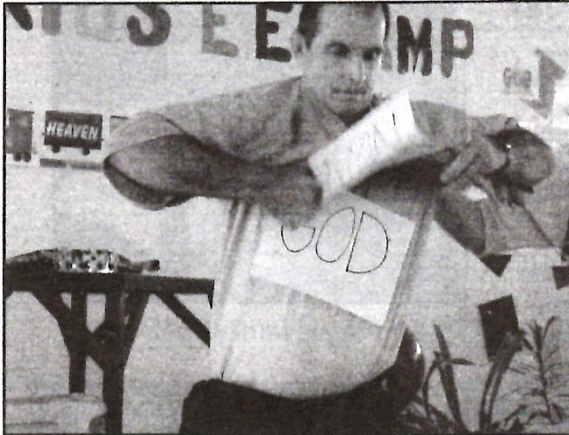

During the KID EE Camp, God again revealed how He uses this unique ministry tool. School was out for Spring Break so some clinicians brought their children along to the training held at a beautiful seaside Bible Camp. During the KIDS EE Clinic, seven year old Lloyd sat quietly beside his mother. He made the crafts, watched the skits and listened to the teachers. Then it happened. While the clinicians were doing "On-The-Job-Training" (OJT), sharing what they were learning, Lloyd didn't just sit quietly by and be unfaithful to the Great Commission. Lloyd was obedient to Jesus' last Command. While the adults were sharing the Gospel, Lloyd started up a conversation with a six year old girl. He presented the complete Gospel outline to her and then led her in prayer to ask Jesus to be her Lord and Savior. He knew how to share God's love with this little girl and led her in a prayer to receive the free gift of Eternal Life. The clinicians were amazed at Lloyd's self confident proclamation of the Gospel. After this, the clinicians really believed what they had been hearing during the training. Children that know Christ as their personal Savior, can and will share what they know with others!

## Street Children Changed Forever

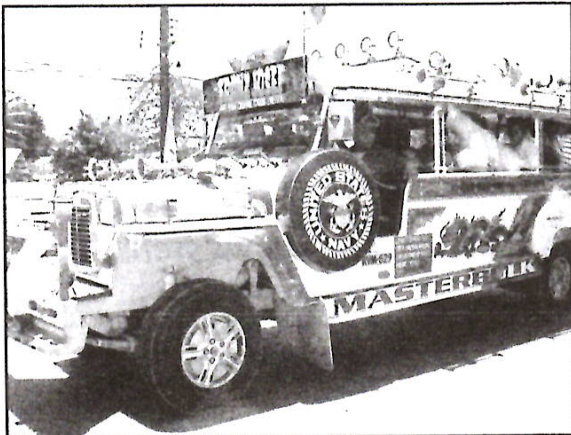
From the waterfront barrios of Cebu City, twelve children came by ferry to the Camp to share their talents and changed lives with the clinicians. They arrived, wide-eyed with wonder. Before this trip, not one of these children had ever ventured beyond the confines of Cebu City. In spite of the squalor of their living conditions and their difficult home situations, these children radiated a confidence and joy that their teachers, Sally and Meia, said came only after they had received Christ as their Lord and Savior through the ministry of KIDS EE. Sally and Meia, who work with Operation Mobilization, were trained in KIDS EE by Pastor NoNo. Incorporating drama and mime, these children do KIDS EE presentations on the streets of Cebu City and lead other children to faith in Christ.

The Warren's enjoyed learning new skills to enhance their KIDS EE Ministry. These skills will be shared with childrens' workers around the world.

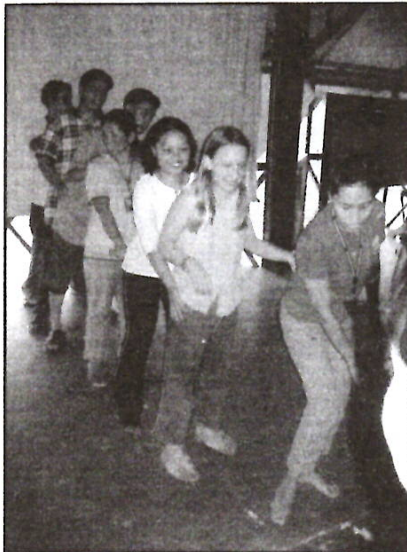
