God has allowed the Warrens to teach KIDS EE around the world. 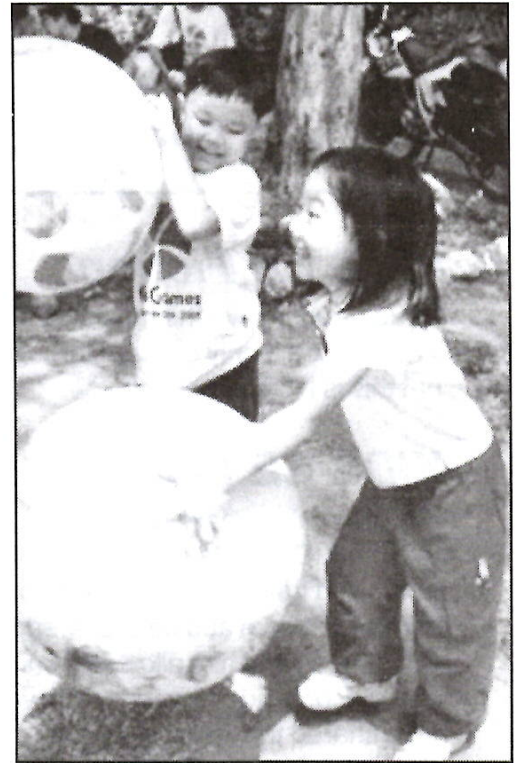

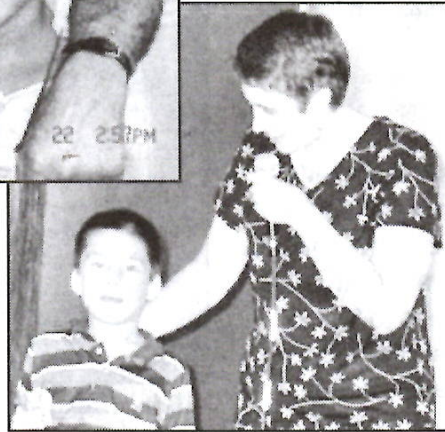

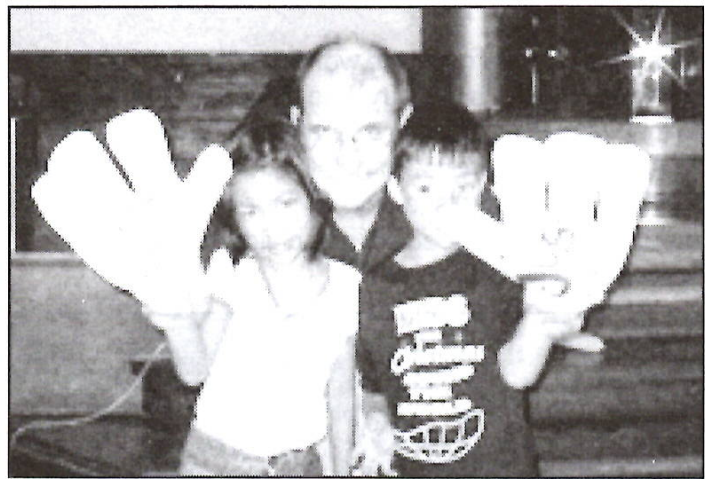

Kids EE Clinic

In April Don was back again in Mindano, Philippines with Pastor NoNo Badoy, doing another Kids EE clinic for 55 adult leaders. One third of these clinicians came from Muslim controlled areas. One of the clinicians from this training is currently en route to a middle eastern country to begin preparations for the very first Kids EE clinic in the entire Middle East!

The 10/40 Window

This year Pastor NoNo became the newly appointed director of Kids and Youth EE for Asia and the Middle East. His area of responsibility includes two thirds of the world's population. In these areas, more than one half of the population is fourteen and under. This area includes much of the 10/40 window, where the vast majority of the unreached people groups live. Through your support, the Warrens will continue to partner with Pastor NoNo.

Our Entire Life Savings!

Pastor NoNo's family spent their entire life savings to go to India and teach the very first Kids EE clinic as a family. Their car was breaking down and they needed a new one. The choice was to buy a new car or go do the clinic. Nono laid the choice before his family. The boys said, "Dad, we need to do this!" and so off to India they went to conduct India's first two KIDS EE clinics.

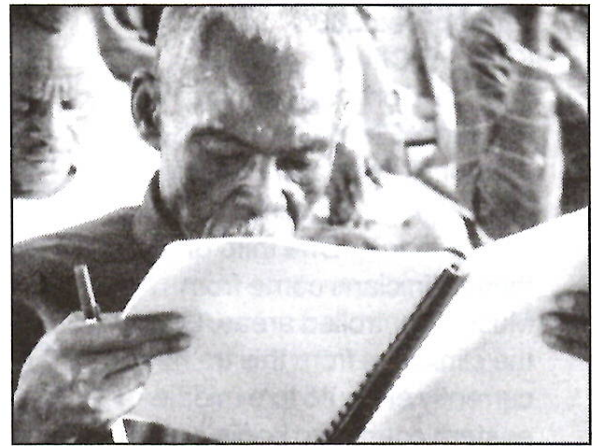
While Don returned to the USA for a clinic at CRPC in Ft. Lauderdale, Pastor NoNo was undertaking a huge project where 150 Kids from 5 Kids EE Implementing Churches from 3 Cities worked together to present the Kids EE Musical. Their EE teams were responsible for the follow-up for those they had invited. The Musical aimed to promote the EE ministry and encourage newcomers to enlist in the training.

The Partnership

Don and Suzy want to partner with Pastor NoNo to reach the unreached people of the world in this 10/40 window. That begins with raising funds for the new clinician who is heading to the Middle East. The Warrens will be helping with the need of about \$4,000 for airfare, clinic materials, and supplies to leave behind for ministry implementation. Pray for this need and that the Lord will give a vision to those who will partners with the Warrens for this exciting opportunity.

Multiplication

Multiplication works in KIDS EE the same as in Evangelism Explosion (EE)-but even faster! And the training of children is really the glorious end-result of the Warrens ministry. This is how it works. Don and Suzy train adult leaders at KIDS EE Clinics who in turn go home to their church. The adult leader then recruits other adult leaders from their church as team leaders. These team leaders sit together with two children each, learning KIDS EE along side the children while the one trained at the KIDS EE Clinic teaches. Everyone is learning together. When they do their "on-the-job training" there are adults, youth, and kids going out together in teams. It becomes an intergenerational family model of EE. In just a few short years these same children will be in Youth EE and then Adult EE. The adult team leaders will continue training other kids. It's a wonderful investment in the future as you partner with the Warrens as they work in the exciting ministry of KIDS EE.

The Three Year Plan

Everywhere the Warrens go, they have a plan to work themselves out of a job! The first year they are invited to train others in KIDS EE, they go and teach a selected group of adult leaders. The second year they return and identify who God is raising up to faithfully use the tools of KIDS EE, assessing who has persevered in training others in their absence. The Warrens then encourage these faithful servants to co-teach a KIDS EE Clinic with them. The third year the Warrens like to go in and only assist the faithful with their teaching; observing and making recommendations in the hopes to equip them to carry on when the Warrens can't be present. And there the Warrens are, without a job and ready to move on to the next area where God opens a door!

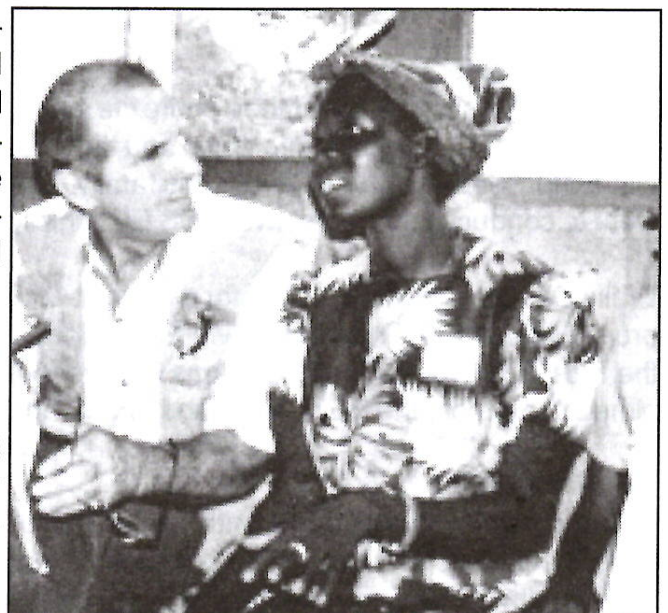
