2006 in Review

The Warrens visited the ongoing work in **Haiti**. They also helped the Haitian ministry by shipping a container of goods. The supplies are helping the Haitian nationals continue to be self-supporting.

Two trips into **Southern Sudan**; teaching, training, working on a school, two seminaries, a training center, a church and a radio station, as well as shipping a container with the radio station equipment and a portable saw-mill. Preparations continue to have the radio station operating by Spring 2007.

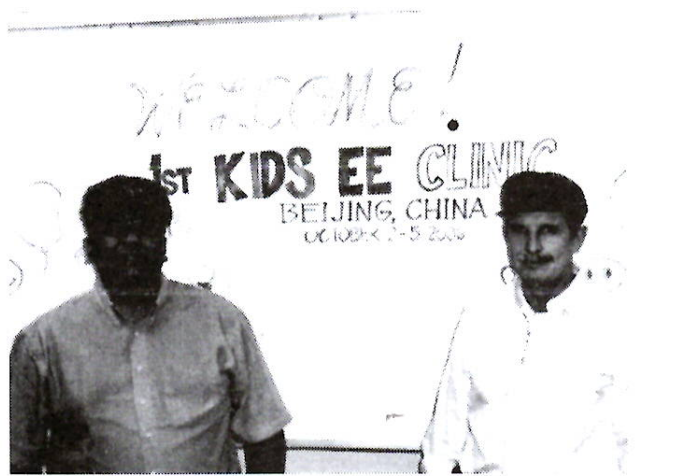

A dream come true

The First Ever . . . KIDS EE Clinic in China

The opportunity to teach in China has been a dream of Don's for many years. Don and Pastor NoNo from the Philippines, have been praying and working together for several years to see the 1st KIDS EE Clinic in China become a reality. It was held at the Beijing International Christian Fellowship (BICF), impacting far beyond the border of China as they trained 28 people from nine different countries, who speak four languages (English, Mandarin, Cantonese and French). God even sent four clinicians from Africa.

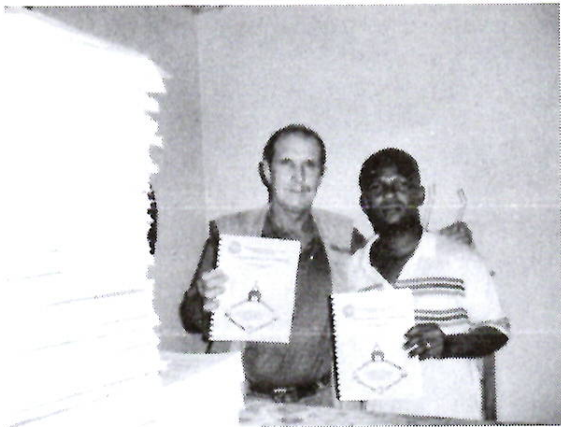
Don was amazed at some of the ways he saw God working in Beijing. He was able to speak on "The Importance of Reaching our Children" in two different services of BICF at two separate locations. Each time, several thousand people were able to hear this message. It was amazing and awesome for him to be worshipping the Lord so freely in this Restricted Access Country. BICF has 14 congregations, from 70 countries, with 4,000 attendees.



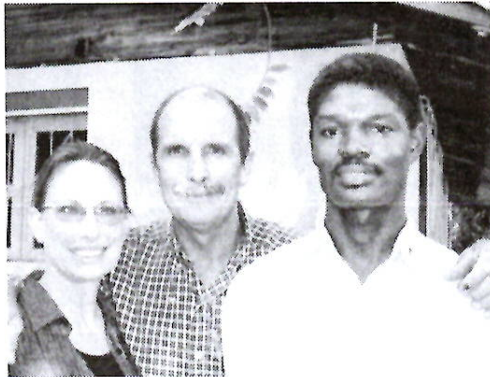
Don witnessed much interest and openness to the Gospel. Bibles were being sold in bookstores for US\$1. The Bibles were printed in China and approved by the Chinese government. More than 1,000 titles of Christian books, such as *The Purpose Driven Life* are now legally printed and sold in China. Invited by a group from BICF, Don and Pastor NoNo attended a celebration for a national holiday held in the open-air courtyard of a 4-star hotel. Over 200 people gathered, singing Christian songs and giving personal testimony to their faith in Christ in this public setting. Those milling by on the street, stopped to listen to this gathering of believers.

Much seems to be changing at this time in Beijing, to the glory of God.

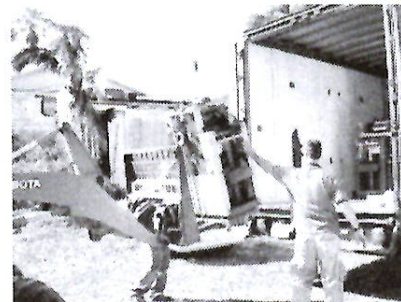
Printed upon order, EE material now shipped throughout Haiti



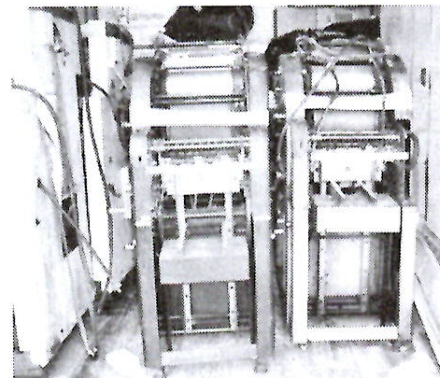

Success in Haiti

In 1994, when Don was first called to work in Haiti, he became aware of a problem. EE Training material was only available there in French. The heart-language of the vast majority of the Haitian people was Creole. This meant that many in Haiti would not be able to learn how to use this effective evangelism tool. Also the EE training material had to be shipped from the US at that time, at great expense relative to Haitian annual income. God burdened Don's heart to help solve these problems. Don organized to have the EE material translated into Creole. Then by shipping donated and purchased printing equipment to various locations around Haiti, this problem was alleviated. In 2006 there were ten (10) EE and KIDS EE Clinics, all taught and organized by Haitians. Jobs have been created for many. Ministry and educational material are now printed and distributed throughout Haiti. When Don and Suzy visited one of the print shops in 2006 with the Haitian National Director, there were stacks of EE Manuals and KIDS EE material laid out to be collated. A textbook had also been printed to be used at the University of North Haiti. The printing equipment and supplies have helped the EE ministry in Haiti become self-supporting and self-sustaining.



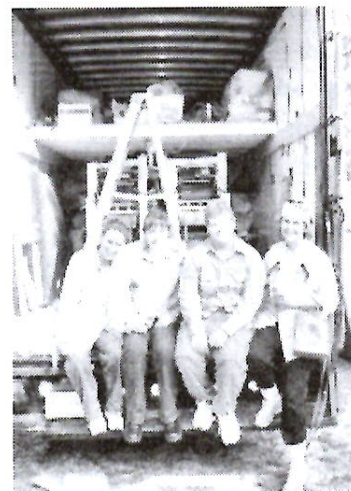
Rev. Paul Hurst helping Don load a printing press on the container

EE Ministry & Training Center of South Haiti in LaCayes, housing a print shop, computer school, and vocational center

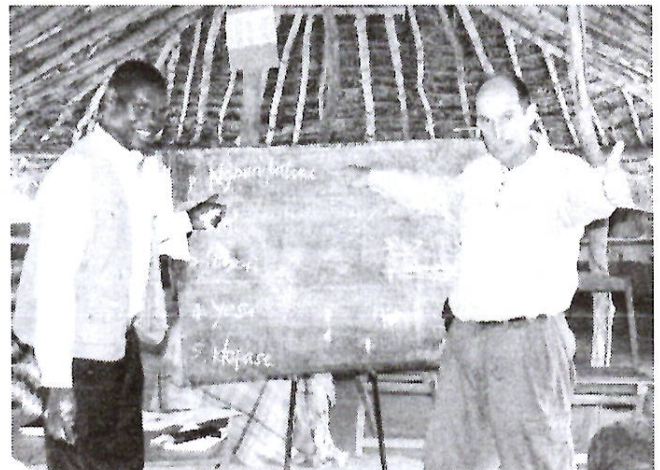

Tribal drums told of the Apairy Seminar. Some walked 60 miles to learn about bee-keeping. Joe came from Massachusetts to share his knowledge. Soon the message to assemble for a seminar will be heard over the radio.

Rev. Jackson, Dean of the Theological Seminary received a mosquito net for his wife and infant. Their month-old child is a surviving twin, their only living child so far. The Jacksons have previously lost eight babies, including this infant's twin. Nutritional supplements were also left for the mother and child. Keep this family in your prayers.



Nursing mothers and the elderly received nearly 1,500 mosquito nets. Don distributed these treasures along with malaria medicine. This donation came through MEI Foundation. This will prevent some of the **3,000 malaria deaths a day** to children under 5 years of age by in Africa.



Traveling 50 miles by motorbike into the Congo where no outsiders have been seen in 24 years, Don was invited by clinicians he had trained previously. Don and Virgil distributed malaria medicine. Don is planning a KIDS EE Clinic for this area in 2007.
